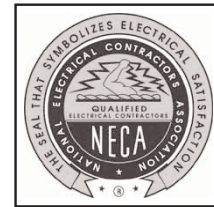

Payment Procedures

As a member, you are provided with a pre-printed dues booklet for your convenience.

Each week's form must be filled out and mailed with two checks.

Enter Manhours for the week.

Enter Total Gross Productive Wages (NYC Payroll) on Line 1.

Multiply Line 1 by .5 of 1% (.005) for AEC dues

AEC MINIMUM is \$40 for Line 2

AEC Cap—\$25,000

Multiply Line 1 by .2 of 1% (.002) for NECA dues

NECA MINIMUM is \$3.44 for Line 3

Or if 75,000 Manhours Cap is met:

Multiply Line 1 by .15 of 1% (.0015)

NECA Cap—150, 000 Manhours

Enter Total of Line 2 + Line 3 on Line 4

Make two checks payable to:

(Check # 1) AEC

(Check # 2) AEC NECA

Please use the double window envelope provided and enclose the form and your signed check. Make sure the Association's address reads through the window and the envelope is stamped and sealed.
